

# #10 Major Triads

To run Major triads:

C F etc..

Detailed description: This block shows the first two major triads, C and F, in 4/4 time. The C triad is played in the first four measures, with each note (C, E, G) repeated three times in a triplet. The F triad is played in the next four measures, also with triplets for each note (F, A, C). Fingerings are indicated: 2 for the second measure of the C triad, 3 for the first measure of the F triad, and 4 for the fourth measure of the F triad.
